Subject: Michael Kriewaldt Scholarship

Dear Deans,

The scholarship was established in the honour of Michael Kriewaldt for his contribution to the mining industry in general, and to Centamin and the Sukari project, Egypt, in particular.

It is envisaged that scholarship will be the foundation for establishment of a foremost international mining research Centre at the Geology Department, Faculty of Science, and Alexandria University.

An agreement was signed with the Centamin Company and Mr. Sami Al-Rajhi. The terms of the agreement included funding two annual scholarships for either a master's or doctorate degree in the field of mineral resources and mining. The scholarship covers the tuition fees, accommodation, transportation, living expenses, and all research requirements for the enrolled students in the program. Also, the research equipment's to establish a Faculty Center of Excellence for research in mining and mineral resources according to the international standards

I appreciate your support for circulating this letter to the geology graduates in your faculty. Applicant wishes to apply for this scholarship must send the following data to hanafyholail@alexu.edu.eg before August 30, 2020.

1. Academic transcripts and information of courses taken, including advanced, placement, and honors courses, would be required, earning a 3.2 CGPA or higher in those courses.
2. A personal statement that describes why the candidate wishes to participate in and outlines their academic and career goals, particularly in mineral resources.
3. Three letters of recommendation that addresses four specific items: probable creativity and interest in mining and mineral resources career; persistence in meeting challenges and goals; assessment of academic potential; and level of performance relative to potential.
4. A proof of candidate English Language proficiency (IELTS, 6.5, or TOEFLE, IBT, 80 and general GRE (to be taken into consideration).
